



Which brings me our **Brother Bruce**. Today Brother Bruce McCallum was moved to the RVH Stroke recovery Floor after being taken off the ventilator last week. His way to recovery will still be difficult but the feeling is so much better today than it was a mere few days ago. Marie encouraged me to continue with our prayers for Brother Bruce as he continues this arduous journey.

I wish to thank our executive, particularly DGK Richard de Faria, and all my Brother Knights for all their dedicated effort and continued support.




